
TB-513 Meeting of Branch 4 Task Force, 9 March 1960

Chairman: Col. J. C. King, USAF,

and other CIA personnel

King told his group that the DDCI by presenting a special policy
directive to the Air Force gave the Air Force evidence that
the Cuban Government have been preparing for an attack
against the United States at Guantanamo Bay and said that an attack on
Cuba is in fact, possible.

Col. King stated that the major problem in this operation is how
to bring Cuba into the truth. He said, "we have been
concerned with certain American islands which would be useful for either FP
or bases. In addition, a number of bases of the USAF of friendly
countries are, at the moment, fulfilling certain military needs, cut
out of Cuba. Operation directed at the members of the CASA-C regime
will be conducted in such a way that the Cuban Government may soon
realize that it is foolish to continue to hold onto Cuba.
The Cuban Government could be eliminated in one package - which is highly
desirable. This operation can be a long, drawn-out affair and the present
situation will not be overcome by the use of force."






