WILLIAM BREMER SAID ARTHUR HADN'T HAD A GIRL FRIEND AND HAD TRIED OUT FOR THE HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL TEAM.

THE MOTHER OF A 16-YEAR-OLD GIRL WHO HAD GONE OUT WITH ARTHUR BREMER SAID SHE CONSIDERED HIM "VERY STRANGE." MRS. MARGARET PEMRICH SAID SHE HAD SAID HELLO TO BREMER EVERY DAY FOR TWO YEARS AT HER SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD POST "AND HE NEVER SAID ANYTHING."

AS FOR HIS DATING HER DAUGHTER, "THEY JUST WENT ON AND OFF ... IT WASN'T A LIVE AFFAIR ... THEY WERE JUST FRIENDS," MRS. PEMRICH SAID.

WILLIAM BREMER, A TRUCK DRIVER WITH THE SAME COMPANY FOR 30 YEARS, SAID HIS SON HAD NEVER HAD A GUN WHILE HE WAS HOME.

MRS. BREMER STAYED IN THE LIVING ROOM. BREMER SAID SHE HAD TRIED TO GET HER SON TO RETURN HOME, BUT HE WANTED TO BE BY HIMSELF BECAUSE HE HAD SOME PART-TIME WORK AS A BUSBOY AND JANITOR AFTER DROPPING OUT OF A PHOTOGRAPHY COURSE AT MILWAUKEE TECHNICAL COLLEGE. HE GRADUATED FROM HIGH SCHOOL HERE.

STEPHEN WASCHE, A HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT FROM MINNESOTA WHO LIVES WITH RELATIVES WHO MANAGE THE BUILDING WHERE ARTHUR BREMER LIVED, SAID BREMER "STAYED PRETTY MUCH TO HIMSELF AND DIDN'T TALK MUCH. HE HAD ONLY ONE VISITOR THAT I KNOW OF -- HIS MOTHER."
