Dear Mr. Lucas,

I cannot locate the copy of the very hasty memo on the Bringuier references I did for Saga as soon as they received the first papers. At the moment I haven't time to do it over. I am writing to suggest that you ask their counsel for it. Martin Singer, the editor, must have given it to them.

The Bringuier Exhibit that ties him to the Cuban Revolutionary Council, voluntarily, is No. 4 (19H176). I am sure Garrison's office will Xerox a copy for you. I understand the New Orleans library has copies and perhaps will do this by phoned request. However, next week I'll be near the Xerox machine that copies from a book. If you do not have them, drop me a note and I'll Xerox all of his testimony and all of Crest Pena's for you.

I have just finished a book I think you will find shocking (no reference to Bringuier in it!). I call it PHOTOGRAPHIC WHITENASH: SUPPRESSED KENNEDY ASSASSINATION PICTURES. It is a private printing, by offset reproduction of a typescript. It has an appendix of 150 pages of photographic reproduction of once-secret documents. I think it is important and interesting and very saleable. My three largest wholesalers, when I asked for their anticipated first month of need, ordered enough to pay for the mechanical cost! I want most of the copies to have the index we have almost finished.

In New Orleans especially I think this book can have great sale. It sells retail for \$4.95. We discount 50% to wholesalers. I presume at least one is among your clients. We also protect them, but charge them shipping costs. I would be more than happy if you could interest a wholesaler.

The book is 6x9 and despite its soft cover, is of hardback quality, with 60 lb paper, stitched binding, etc. I think if he lets the libraries know he has it he'll sell a number to them, Ditto schools. Also, if he has any institutional business, we still have copies of the original editions of both earlier books and the institutions still order them from us in preference to the Dell reprint.

I will very much appreciate any help you can give us with this.
