

New Evidence in JFK Slaying?

DALLAS — Film taken by an amateur photographer just before the assassination of President John F. Kennedy may show two people in the window of the Texas School Book Depository, where assassin Lee Harvey Oswald was supposed to have shot the president — acting alone.

In a copyrighted story in today's edition, the Dallas Morning News published a full page of enlarged pictures that a House Assassinations Committee film technician said indicated two men were in "the sniper's nest" on the sixth floor of the building just before the fatal shots were fired.

If his interpretation is correct, the evidence would shatter the Warren Commission's contention that Oswald worked alone.
