SC: DeFreeze and Wheeler both escaped from California prisons within a short time of each other. That seemed a little peculiar to me. Do you find any similariles between the prison escapes of Defreeze. Wheeler, and James Bari Bay?

MB: After two years of heavy programming, DeFreeze's mentors at Vacaville, apparently decided that he was ready for the next step in the script: his "escape;" DeFreeze was transferred from Vacaville to Soledad prison, near Salinas, California, in December, 1973. Four months later, in March, 1974. DeFreeze "escape" from Soledad But using the word "escape" is misleading; the facts are, that DeFreeze was placed in a situation at Soledad where all he had to do was to walk away from the prison.

DeFreeze's escape from Soledad, parallels James Earl Ray's "escape" from the Missouri penitentiary. Eighteen months later, Ray became the alleged assassin of Martin Luther King. Ray was a parsy too. Now Ray seems to want to tell the truth about the assassination of Martin Luther King, and one of the things he said, in a recent press conference, was, "Ask them how I got out of jail."

A prisoner from Soledad has stated, "While Donald DeFreeze was here, I had a few conversations with him. I have always questioned his departure as being a simple walk-away. ## People's May Get Rector's ame

The latest twist in the continuit saga of People's Park is a recommendation from a firm of col sultants that the Regents of L Berkeley should go ahead wi plans to build a 238-unit housi project on the site, and name t complex after James Rector, the student who was killed by police during the 1969 People's Park

The report, which cost \$28,000 was prepared by Gruen, Gruen an Associates, of San Francisco, firm that has come under fire from opponents of the University's scheme as being too marketoriented to prepare a report on the human and environmental issues involved.

The consultants' report, billed as a preliminary environmental study, calls for a slightly scaled-down version of an earlier plan which would eliminate the pro-posed 63 studios, which students are not interested in.

Much opposition has been voiced since the University announced plans for housing on the 2.8-acre sile, which has been used as a free parking fol and public park after a crowd tore down a chain-link fence there just three years ago Local residents feel the proposed housing complex would cause traffic congestion and an overcrowded residential area with nowhere for people to play

The consultants acknowledge the symbolic importance of the site but propose that UC could "mitigate the negative impact" of eliminating the park by naming the housing project after James Rector. It wil be interesting to see whether the Regents go along with such a cheap and cynical gesture.

## CINQUE CALLED Park Plan POLICE PATS

Gen Cinque has been charged with being a member of California's intelligence police network and under the personal direction of Att Gen Evelle Younger.

This charge was made by Donald Freed, author of the book EXECU-TIVE ACTION and student of establishment assassination conspiracies.

On KPFA Tuesday night, Freed flatly stated that Younger "three times" held up the extradition of Donald DeFreeze, who is alleged to be Gen Cinque of the SLA, because of "the hysteria on the part of state police officials to have Black agents for penetration."

Freed claims Cinque's file 'has been removed' from state offices and placed" in the safe of a watchcaptain" along with the files of those two Black escapees from San Quentin two weeks ago.

Within the past months, four Blacks somehow have been able to 'walk away" from California intitutions when, previously, Blacks had seldom even been allowed to be near a fucking place they could 'walk away' from in the first

'For some time, DeFreeze, worked with the LA police intelli-gence network," Freed went on, speaking under the sponsorship of a group which brought Louis Tackwood in from the cold and helped him publish his expose of the LA police under the pocket-book title The Glasshouse Tape.

Freed said Younger is "now getting a bit apprehensive" on how "his agent is operating"--and that explains our Att Gen's recent statements and the FBI's warrant out on Cinque.

Freed also indicates that the SLA activity is planned by the establishment against Black and left organizations. 'This is the meaning of the SLA bank holdup" in San Francisco, he said.

He also felt that the Black Panther bust Tuesday was the first one to come down under this planned program of police-raids

and harassment. Curidusly, however, Bobby Seale, in a bress con-ference, and Elaine Brown-both founders of the Panthers--were mute on this point.

At a press conference Tuesday, both Seale and Brown stressed the "political nature" of the police bust, in that the Black Panthers are already planning their next Oakland political campaign. "We got 36 percent of the vite

the next election," said Seald Nowhere in all their remarks was the word "SLA" ever mentioned.

In the broadcast remarks of another assassinationologist, Mae Brussell, she stated Monday (before the Panther bust) that the SLA was a "CIA-planned operation to destroy the Black movement in America."

Around the walls of Berkeley, however, the SLA is Number On on the Hit Parade. "Don't Vote SLA" is a recent slogan, along with photos of Tania Patricia Hearst with the slogan: "Tinia We Love You."

## SLA SET-UP? PANTHER BUST SEEN AS STAGE OF RENEWED POLICE PLO

by David Armstrong The bust of 14 Black Panther Party workers in an East 29th St. "precinct house" in Oakland earlier this week takes us back, as though through a political timewarp, to the days then the Panthers were being periodically jailed and shot for their activities. The fact that charges were dropped "pend-ing further investigation" on the day of arraignment makes the bust all the more bizarre.

Even the page one photo in the Chron--printed in the same issue as their breathless "Girls of the SLA" feature--was a familiar proto-type. Rows of ammunition and automatic weapons supposedly confiscated in the house hulked wickedly against the white background of what looked like a sheet spread upon the floor. That photo went a long way towards resurrecting (or trying to) the image of jive-macho violence the Panthers have been working to shed in Oakland with their community organizing projects, electoral efforts and survival programs.

The bust also raises the possibility of a renewed pattern of widespresd police harassment against the Black Panthers. Clearly the Panthers feel that it's more than a possibility.

Chairman Bobby Seale describes the raid as an attempt to "drain and discredit" the Panthers, add-ing that it was "the same old political agent-provocateur operations." Panther members in the past were frequently arrested and charged with possession of weapons such as machine guns, but no machine guns eyer showed up in court in those earlier trials. Seale said.

This time DeFreeze was jailed. He was sent to Vacaville for a short time, then to Soledad, where he escaped on March 5, 1973, by simply walking away from a minimum security section of the prison where a guard left him alone to work on a boiler.

SLA communiques of the last several months have bitterly attacked the Panthers as penthouse revolutionaries, while law and order forces in Oakland have attacked them from the opposite end, portraying them as dangerous firebrands. In actuality, retort the Panthers, the law and order types are afraid the Panthers could win power in Oakland next

year. Legally. That is the primary reason for the raid, according to Bobby Seale. The East Oakland house contained the names and addresses of 3,000 precinct workers who have already been organized for a campaign to elect five city council members and two board of education members next spring, as well as voter registration records from last year's mayoral campaign a hen the Panthers had only a third as many workers. A campaign such as the one planned for next year would cost a minimum of \$300,000, which is, coincidentally, almost identical to the bail money originally needed

Younger retained DeFreeze as an agent, Freed says, despite reports that he was "a homocidal maniac," because of a pressing need for agents in the Black community

The Black Panther further supports Freed's assertion by reporting that the state of California has consistently refused to extradite DeFreeze to New Jersey, where he has been wanted "since 1965 to face charges of kidnapping, extortion and assault with a deadly weapon."

'The first known act of connivance with California police by De-Freeze occurred on Dec. 6, 1967," reads The Black Panther report. "DeFreeze set up a crime partner, Ronald Coleman, with a telephone call and led police to a cache of more than 200 rifles and automatic pistols in Coleman's apartment. The guns had been stolen from an army surplus goods store in Los Angeles."

DeFreeze and Coleman were released on probation, however, and
although he was later "picked up
carrying a fully loaded semi-automatic M-68 nine mm rifle," DeFreeze did not go to jail. Two
years later, DeFreeze tried to
shoot his way out of a bank after
trying to cash a stolen check.

Officer Berger said the raid stemmed from a complaint by Michael Foster, 21, a former West Berkeley Panther, who said he was beaten last Monday night on Berkeley's Sacramento St. by three men, one of whom he identified as Kolar, a BPP member. Kolar wasn't at the East 29th St. address when the police came calling, but the other 14 were.

They were charged with possession of firearms, marijuana and cocaine, radio equipment that could monitor police calls, "a bloody baseball bat" and, of course "conspiracy." None of this could be proven at arraignment time, as District Attorney Baldwin admitted, but the DA left the Berkeley courthouse Wednesday afternoon with promises of more to come.
