to Community

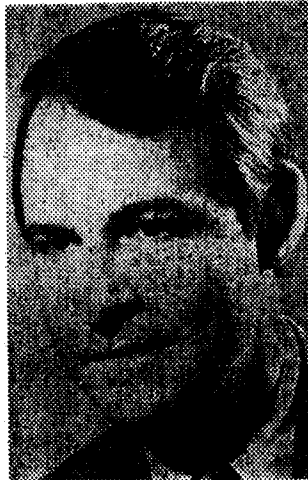
The New Orleans Jaycees' annual distinguished service award was presented at the Fontainebleau Motor Hotel to Edward Scannell Butler.
