Some years ago, when you were asked to locate JFK's brain, I told you I was certain that it was in the possession of the archives, which would pretend otherwise, because it had been given to the Kennedy library, which is part of the Archives.

I've just received the enclosed records, which I think confirm my belief. I send them because CBS has a very large assassination file in New York, I do not know under whom.

I got these from the archivesm which did not provide them years ago in response to my requests of it. They are actually referrals to the Archives from the Justice Department, which only recently has acted on referrals to it by the Nuvy - in response to my FOIA request of 1977, of the "avy!

After the letter agreement signed 2/25/65, there was a "Memorendum of Tranfer" which I did get just in time to preclude my filing suit for it. CBS does have it because others held a press conference to pretend that they had broken it loose and gave copies to CBS and others. The transfer covered in the Memorandum includes the autopsy naterials.

I have much more pertinent information, if CBS is ever interested. Mone of it supports the popular belief that I suspect had official parentage, that Bobby Kennedy had physical possession of these materials.

The Richman of the routing slip on the second record is Nertin Richman, then of the Justice Department's Office of Legal Counsel.

Shortly after the date of this second record an additional letter agreement transferred the autopsy film and clothing to GSA. It was signed for the JFK estate by Burke Marshall.
