ASSASSINATIONS OF KURNEDYS, KING AND SHOOTING OF WALLACE TO BE REEXAMINED BY CLE RUPORTS ON CBS TELEVISION NETWORK

"CBS REPORTS: The Assassinations," a two-hour long reexamination of the killings of President John F. Kennedy, Senator Robert F.

Linnedy and the Riverend Markin Luther King Jr., and the shooting of Governor George C. Wallace, will be broadcast in November on the CBS Talevision Network.

CES REPORTS Correspondent Dan Rather will report and narrate the broadcast. The executive producer will be Leslie Midgley.

Bill Leonard, CBS News Senior Vice President, Director of Public Affairs Broadcasts, said: "The assassination of President Kennedy was the first of four violent attacks against American leaders who, each in his own way, had stirred people and emotions. The last of those fearful events was in 1972 when Governor Wallace was shot and paralyzed. Each of thise cases was officially closed. But questions paralyzed, not only asout each individual crime. Theories have multiplied, including theories that each assassination attempt was somehow related to others. In this study, CBS News will explore the theories, investigate the evidence, and try to find answers to the questions that are most disturbing."
