U.S. Envoy Returns to Chile

U.S. Ambassador to Chile George Landau returned to Santiago to express U.S. concern over Chile's refusal to extradite three Chileans indicted for the murder in Washington in 1976 of exiled Chilean diplomat Orlando Letelier.

State Department spokesman Tom Reston said Landau, who was recalled for consulations two weeks ago as a sign of protest, will convey to authorities U.S. concern about the Chilean court's decision not to extradite the former intelligence officials.
