

3. On 16 May 1970, following transportation to [REDACTED] and a welcoming speech by [REDACTED], the Seminar opened at 10 a.m. with a lecture and a demonstration of current monitoring and alarm systems by the [REDACTED] Division, Office of Security. In the afternoon, the [REDACTED] Division, Office of Security, provided a briefing and display of audio countermeasure equipment and techniques, and the [REDACTED] Division, DD/P, presented a demonstration of explosive and incendiary devices fabricated from common household articles. A dinner in honor of the police officials was followed by a presentation of the Agency produced film "Need to Know." Of interest is that the viewers believed this production to be a viable public relations achievement and worthy of presentation to other selected groups.

4. On 17 May the guests participated in recreational activities both at [REDACTED]. In addition, many visited the foreign weapons collection at [REDACTED]. The Seminar was concluded at 5:30 p. m. on return to Washington [REDACTED].

5. Comments by the participants were very favorable, and all felt that the Seminar was very beneficial. In this regard, the informal meetings provided an opportunity for the participants to discuss many of their mutual problems.
