SUBJECT: Liaison With Municipal Agencies
(Photography and Surveillance Training)

1. Recently [redacted], [redacted] Metropolitan Police Department, conveyed to a representative of the [redacted] the need for some training for some of his men. He said that the training needs are in the areas of photography, surveillance and surreptitious entry. This was passed on to you, as you will recall, and the Director of Security, when you contacted him for his reaction, approved, and suggested that the other police departments in the area be contacted to determine whether or not they wanted to participate. The intelligence squads of Fairfax, Arlington, Prince Georges and Montgomery Counties, and the Organized Crime Unit of MPD, were contacted, enthusiastically asked for the training, and spelled out their total needs, which [redacted] has detailed in Attachment A.

2. In preparing the groundwork for the training, it was determined that [redacted], with the cooperation of [redacted], is in the process of preparing a training course in lock-smithing handskills for two members each from the Arlington County Police Department Intelligence Squad and the Metropolitan Police Department Bomb Squad. Through [redacted], and with the approval of the Director of Security, the [redacted] has invited two representatives each from the Intelligence Squads of Fairfax County, Montgomery County and Prince Georges County Police Departments to participate.
