In addition to the descriptive summaries of all persons involved in the Cuban People's Revolutionary Armed Forces, the CIA has made FBI and CIA reports and background information of the Cuban People's Revolutionary Guards in the National Archives. None of these documents is available in the voluminous files or its 26 published volumes.

None of these parties linked these Cubans to Oswald, although one of the agency's investigations was never completed because of the sudden illness of one of the Cubans, who claimed to have met Oswald with two other Cubans.

THE FBI AND CIA INVESTIGATIONS OF THESE CUBANS ARE NOW UNDER INVESTIGATION BY DISTRICT ATTORNEY JOHN GALLAGHER OF NEW ORLEANS, WHO MADE A PROGRESS REPORT DEVELOPED IN THAT CITY WHICH CULMINATED IN THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. THIS INVESTIGATION ALREADY HAS EXAMINED SEVERAL FBI REPORTS INVOLVING PARTIES OF THESE CUBANS.

Whether the Garrison investigation, which Administration officials are carefully watching, had anything to do with the Katzenbach committee's check on CIA involvement with JUKE isn't known.

ADMINISTRATION INSIDERS report that Ray and his Cuban refugee group are well known to Katzenbach and CIA authorities. Following the Bay of Pigs Invasion, Ray made numerous visits to Washington and conferred many times with then-Attorney General Robert Kennedy, Katzenbach and several CIA officials.

During this period most anti-Castro refugee leaders wouldn't have anything to do with Ray because of his leftist views and previous ties with Castro.
