Fulbright to Seek Curb on USIA

Sen. J. William Fulbright, taking issue with the recommendations of a presidential commission, wants Congress to ban distribution of U.S. Information Agency material in the United States.

Fulbright, D-Ark., announced yesterday he would submit an amendment to that effect to a pending bill. A White House advisory commission recently recommended that USIA material be made available domestically upon request.
