Ousted Tofte Sues CIA's Director

Hans V. Tofte, the Central Intelligence Agency undercover official whose contract was terminated recently after he "went public," filed a damage suit in Federal Court yesterday against CIA Director Richard Helms and three other persons.

The other defendants are Kenneth R. Slocum, the CIA employe who found classified CIA documents in Tofte's former Georgetown home on July 23, while looking for an apartment; Slocum's wife, Judy; and Charles D. Speake, the CIA security officer who accompanied the Slocums back to the house the next day.

According to the suit, the defendants unlawfully instigated a plan to enter the home, at 1667 35th st. nw., and that part of the plan was to take a letter valued at \$25,000—the sum requested in damages.
