MANILA—The Philippine congress has established a seven-man ocmmittee to investigate CIA activities in the Philippines, ferret out Indonesian spies, and examine Communist activities. Sen. Lorenzo Sumulong has promised to introduce a bill to make known CIA agents register. The spy hunt began when Justice Secretary Jose Vulo dismissed Jose Lukban, head of the National Bureau of Investigation, and intimated that many Philippine officials have been passing in secrets to the CIA. While some Philippine officials approve the spy hunt, others ave suggested that Yulo should stop watching spy movies.
