1. Reference is made to your memorandum of 24 September 1964,  
Subject: Lee Harvey OSWALD, Internal Security - Russia - Cuba.

2. According to your memorandum, [REDACTED] who has  
come to the attention of this office and your Bureau through our  
HUNTER channel, advised Mrs. Ruth PAINE that his son, [REDACTED]  
who resides in the USSR, had met Marina OSWALD prior to the time she  
came to the United States. It was indicated in your memorandum that  
a review of our HUNTER material be made to determine whether further  
traces of [REDACTED] and his relatives in the USSR could be located.  
We are forwarding for your files all available HUNTER items relating  
to the [REDACTED] family. As you will note, these items are not fully  
translated as they are long, rambling, ungrammatical and, in the words  
of the translator, frequently incomprehensible.
