

On July 8, 1964, Mrs. North Circle, Apartment A. Dallas, Texas, advised that is the former wife of JAMES V. ALLRED, Jr. Mrs. ALLRED Texas, advised that she denied stating that she had ever seen an envelope addressed to her husband bearing the name LEE HARVEY OSWALD. Mrs. ALLRED stated that she has thrown away most of the material formerly belonging to her husband. Mrs. ALLRED further stated that it is her recollection that her former husband belonged to an organization called the Youth Freedom Society which Mrs. ALLRED described as being the same organization which LEE HARVEY OSWALD had belonged to in New Orleans, and Which was pro-Cuban. Mrs. ALLRED stated it was her understanding that OSWALD was passing out material for the Youth Freedom Society when he was arrested by the New Orleans, Louisiana police in August of 1963. Mrs. ALLRED further claimed that she recalled seeing copies of "The Worker" which Mrs. ALLRED described as a Communist Party publication published in New York City. As to the radical beliefs of her Mormer husband, Mrs. ALLRED stated that her former husband would do anything for money and she does not have any proof that he is in any way assisting Cuba. However, she feels that he is capable of such an act because of his unscrupulous character.







The Baltimore Sun newspaper of September 28, 1964, contained the following article dealing with THOMAS G. BUCHANAN:

"The Warren commission yesterday released its report of the assassination of President KENNEDY. A Baltimore-born author was ready with his rebuttal.

"THOMAS G. BUCHANAN, JR. thinks LEE HARVEY OSWALD did not fire the fatal shot and did not act alone.

"The author's book has undoubtedly added to the malaise about the assassination that is felt to a great degree in Europe and to a lesser degree in America.

"The book will be published in America on November 22

"Mr. BUCHANAN, 45, has lived in Paris for the last three years but was back in Baltimore yesterday.

"Was Army Captain

"He went to Calvert School, Lawrenceville, Yale and George Washington University and was an Army captain in France during World War II.

"Mr. BUCHANAN is a soft-spoken man, quick with his facts but not beyond a flash of humor as he dredges through the stack of documents he has accumulated on the Dallas tragedy.

"That stack of documents included the Warren report summary, yesterday.

"It is a mass of data accumulated by the commission staff, of immeasurable value in attempting to understand the events of November 22.

"But the interpretation given to this data by the commission seems to me to be unjustified in many respects.

"'Notably, the explanation of how OSWALD received a passport in 1963...and the explanation as to how the murder weapon was identified at first as a 7.65 Mauser' and later said to be an Italian carbine of different caliber.

"He said there was an element of choice in selecting the evidence and the commission had chosen the evidence that tended to confirm the hypotheses that there was a lone assassin.

"But other and more convincing evidence to the contrary has been underemphasized or ignored, he said.

"He said the commission had placed 'unjustified reliance'

on Ruby's 'unsubstantiated' statement that he did not know OSWALD, 'a statement contradicted by ten witnesses.

"'My position,' Mr. BUCHANAN said, 'is between the extremes of the Warren Commission's lone assassin theory and MARK LANE's position that OSWALD was wholly innocent of the murder of TIPPETT and the assassination.'

"New York Lawyer

"Mr. LANE is a New York lawyer who has appeared before the Warren Commission and made several lecture tours on behalf of his theory of the assassination which wholly exonerates OSWALD.

"Mr. BUCHANAN did not testify before the commission but was interviewed by the Justice Department and gave the commission a manuscript of his book.

"Mr. BUCHANAN thinks 'the preponderance of evidence' is against OSWALD having been the unknown assailant who fired a shot at Maj. Gen. EDWIN A. WALKER in April 1963.



The organization is completely controlled and dominated by the Communist Party, Maryland - D. C. District.

The "National Guardian", "established by the American Labor Party in 1947 as a 'progressive' weekly. \* \* \* Although it denies having any affiliation with the Communist Party, it has manifested itself from the beginning as a virtual official propaganda arm of Soviet Russia".

On May 25, 1964, a second source advised that the Open Forum of Maryland continues to be completely controlled and dominated by the local Communist Party. 



In reading the information contained herein, it is important to bear in mind that Pascual Gongora is presently an imate at Creedmore State Mental Hospital, Queens, New York, where medical authorities have labeled him as Psychotic.

Of additional interest is the fact that Attorney James Egan is attempting to obtain the release from Creedmore of Gongora on the basis of a writ of habeas corpus. A hearing date for Gongora is now set for June 6, 1967.

On February 28, 1967, a feature article appeared in El Tiempo, one of New York's daily Spanish newspapers, written by Editor Stanley Ross, which alleged that Premier Fidel Castro of Cuba sent eight teams to the United States for the purpose of assassinating President John F. Kennedy. In addition, Ross was interviewed on several radio and television news programs being broadcasted in the New York vicinity, at which time he made statements similar to those appearing in the newspaper article.

In substance, Ross claimed that Gongora had informed American authorities three days prior to the President's assassination that Castro intered to order President Kennedy killed, and that this plan was to be carried out by six to eight teams sent to the United States by Castro. According to Ross, Gongora was suspected of being a Cuban agent by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

When he was picked up three days prior to the assassination he freely admitted that he was a member of one of the teams sent to New York to await the opportunity of killing the President. Other teams were said to have been sent to other cities such as Dallas where the President was due to make visits.

Gongora is quoted as having said that Castro was convinced that Kennedy was planning to have him killed as he had done to Ngo Dinh Diem of Vietnam, and that Castro decided to kill Kennedy before he, Kennedy, got him.

Ross related that when the President was assassinated Gongora was in the Immigration and Naturalization Service building in Manhattan and that the North American authorities did not know what to do with their prisoner. They feared that if they announced his detention, the public, in fury and sadness over Kenedy's death, would kill innocent and defenseless Cuban anti-Castroites in the streets. As a result, the authorities sought permission from Mexico and Canada to deport Gongora to Cuba via their countries. Both countries refused to do it. Finally, Spain agreed to send Gongora back to Cuba, but the Castro government was afraid and refused to recognize Gongora as one of their agents.

Ross went on to say that it would not be surprising to him if Gongora were still in the United States under another name, inasmuch as he, Ross, claimed to have knowledge that Gongora had suggested to the authorities at Immigration and Naturalization Service that they send him to KeyWest, Florida. This in brief is the article as written by Stanley Ross.





On Pebruary 24, 1967, who stated she is still living in New York, came to the Charlotte Office of the FBI and stated that since June, 1966, she has been engaged in research concerning the assassination of former President JOHN F. KENNEDY. She drew analogies between this assassination

and the crucifixion of Jesus. She said that from statements made to KENNEDY prior to his assassination, as they appear in the book by WILLIAM MANCHESTER and from statements made by LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY, she has come to the conclusion that an FBI Agent was responsible for the assassination of KENNEDY. She stated upon her return to New York City she planned to study further her analysis of the assassination.

On June 12, 1967, again came to the Charlotte Office of the FBI at which time she stated she had continued to conduct research about the assassination of the late President KENNEDY and had "established beyond doubt" that a member of one of the security agencies which she named as the FBI, Secret Service or the Central Intelligence Agency was responsible for the assassination of President KENNEDY. She had with her voluminous notes and reference material which she claimed would prove her allegation. At her own request she left this material with the desire it be reviewed and returned to her. After having been reviewed it has been returned to her on June 16, 1967, to the same New York address.

During August 1967, the office of Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), Los Angeles, California, furnished a copy of a handwritten letter which they received in the mail from Los Angeles.


