

JACKIE NOW NAMES OF J.I

Jackie Onassis knows more about the assassination of John F. Kennedy than the public has ever been told. Not only does she know that Lee Harvey Oswald was not the only person involved in the killing, she also knows the identities of the assassins.

This startling disclosure comes from well-known writer Christian Cafarakis, the Greek author of "The Fabulous Jackie", a book which has caused many raised eyebrows around the world since its publication earlier this year.

According to Cafarakis, Ari Onassis financed a team of private eyes to uncover the truth about the death of President Kennedy, shortly after the assassination on that rainy day in Dallas.

While official sources remain grimly silent, and attempts have been made to discredit Cafarakis' alleged facts, the Canadian 'Montreal Star', reviewing Cafarakis' book, states, "Cafarakis admits to having interrogated scores of people... to get the intimate details which spill across his pages."

Another report, reprinted from the Washington Post in the Toronto Star, agrees that Cafarakis states: "Ari financed a 19-month investigation by private investigators into the death of President Kennedy shortly after the assassination."

The report goes on to state: "In 27 pages, the report is said to conclude that the official Warren Commission into the killing was a whitewash, and it reveals the name of Kennedy's assassins."

Observers are convinced that Jackie has seen the report.

"Jackie loved John F. Kennedy," a writer recently alleged simply. "Few doubts can exist that she has seen the results of the Onassis-financed investigation."

"She must now know as much as Ari does about the identities

of her murdered husband's killers."

Expert opinion judges that Cafarakis may well have uncovered facts which State officials would prefer to keep hidden.

"If this was an isolated report it might be discounted as a fabrication," said an observer. "But Cafarakis shows that he has carefully researched his book.

"His attention to detail and knowledge of intimate facts of the private lives of the Onassis family can lead us to presume that he has unearthed facts which have been carefully concealed for years."

In a minute analysis of Cafarakis' book, would-be detractors have been unable to disprove any of the author's statements, many gained firsthand from servants and employees who are constantly close to Jackie and Ari.

The best the critics can do to cast doubts of Cafarakis' accuracy is to find a few minor errors which the critics themselves admit are nothing more than "pure lint-picking."

Cafarakis' English version of his book identifies Houston in place of Dallas as the site of the assassination. Onassis' jewelers, Van Cleef and Arpels,

are misprinted as "Van Clift and Arpels", while the Marquis of Blandford is misidentified as the Duke of Blandford.

"If these are the only three errors which can be found in the length of the book — which was translated from the French original, so they may not be Cafarakis' errors — then we are forced to place faith in the facts which he presents," said an investigator, who declined to be identified. "No one has come forward to deny the basic evidence that Cafarakis presents so lucidly."

"I feel that this matter should be much more closely investigated."

To prove his deep knowledge of what went on before and after Ari's marriage to Jackie, Cafarakis offers page after page of details which show a close and well-researched intimacy with the Onassis menage.

"The book reveals Jackie as a nail-biting tightwad when it comes to running her own household," writes U.S. journalist Jonathan C. Randal, in a special report for the "Toronto Star". "\$10 a day for family food and help, but a spendthrift when laddling out her husband's seemingly limitless funds."

"Twenty-four hours a day she always has her favorite bottle of pink champagne within arm's reach. A special ice bucket is kept outside her door at night

and she even sips it when tending her vegetable plot on Skorprios."

Other episodes in the private life of Ari and Jackie reveal that the French sheets which Ari used on his bed "were so prickly to the touch of his spouse that she ordered American ones."

As a matter of record, Jackie is said to travel everywhere with a special suitcase of sheets and to instruct her maids to change them daily, or even twice daily if she takes a nap.

Cafarakis has also checked closely into the celebrated marriage contract between the famous couple.

The details of the \$10,000 a month personal expenses for Jackie, \$5,000 for John-John and Caroline, and Jackie's guaranteed \$20,000,000 plus \$180,000 yearly alimony in case of divorce, are well known.

But Cafarakis has also uncovered a clause in the contract which provides for Jackie and Ari to have their bodies preserved in liquid nitrogen after they die.

"The process is known as 'cryogenization' ", stated a famous U.S. mortician. "Jackie and Ari have arranged for their bodies to be kept at extremely low temperatures in lead-lined coffins when they eventually pass on."

"Then when medical science has found the cure for whatever

caused their deaths, they will be brought back to life again."

Facts such as those have lent great credence to Cafarakis' claims concerning the report on JFK's death.

"When you weigh an alleged fact, you set it against the background of supporting evidence," said a New York lawyer. "Cafarakis' details stand up well under investigation, so there is little reason to doubt his allegations about the assassination report."

"Many people would like to see Jackie and Ari forced to reveal the contents of that 27-page report."

Little doubt exists that the report has been turned over to U.S. officials. Yet no word has leaked out from any American agency.

"If the assassins are named — and there is recent evidence linking Mafia associates with the killing of the President — the proper authorities should take some form of action," stated a widely-circulated report earlier this year. "Thousands of Americans believe that Lee Harvey Oswald did not kill JFK by himself."

"The many holes in the Warren Commission's report do nothing but convince people that the whole story has not been told."
