Inspector pointed out that ordinarily if a person failed to appear in answer to a jaywalking summons, a bench warrant would be issued for his arrest and that the records of the MTPD contained no cutstanding warrants based upon this type of violation during the pertinent period.

connection with Supervisor and Inquiry concerning innocuous calls previously received by the individuals in Toronto whose identities subject assumed while in foronto during the period from April 8 to May 6, 1968, attention is called to Buffalo airtel to the Bureau dated 6/11/68 with which were forwarded two copies of a memorandum setting forth a chronology of subject's activities while in Toronto insofar as was known at that time and which included specific references to the innocuous calls received by the individuals whose identities RAY assumed.
