Dear Steve,

Today I sent you another 10 PW, insured. If you get the first mailing, please let me know.

Your letter from KET, mailed 3/16, was here. There is not quite a stack, for I've been able to do nothing since I was there. The past two hard weeks have been New Orleans, here and there, and I've not been able to keep up with the mail. Sciombra left today. He may be in Washington tonight, and I may go down there again with him in the a.m. on another investigation, part of a series we worked on. He was here when you called and I discussed it with him. He is aware of this sort of thing and can do little but regret it. At least he knows. I then showed him the Fred Zetetic item, which fits well... Your former friend has been generous with the friend of us all, with, for example, a \$350.00 watch! That sort of thing helps him only.

Moo has no idea who Tom can be. Never heard of him. He read your note and the paper item (I do not have the first article).

Phone today re: last paragraph on subpoena, etc. There is nothing I can say. I didn't see Jim the last five days I was there, and Alcock asked me to say nothing on the record about the response, hence, since I had started to tell Jim Lawrence, that had to be in confidence. Speak to him, as I did tonight, with a suggestion.
