Dear Steve,

In writing you in haste today I forgot several things. I think I should speak to Hathcock. Would you please let him know my schedule? Last time he said he never got my messages until I got through to him at home, the last day. If, when you speak to him, he has a current address on "The Professors", Dennis Harber, I'd like it before I get there. I have someone looking for him. I know his general area and have a friend there.

Perhaps you have not yet gotten it and if you have, you may have been and may continue to be too busy. But it is my hope to complete going over CCUP before I leave so Lil can retype it in my absence. So, if it is at all possible, send me your suggestions pronto, so I can incorporate them. This will be the retyping for offset and it will be hard and costly to make additions later. Soon she will be going to work and for 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ months will be able to do little typing. I'll bring the additions that are done with me. They may be extensive.

Something is bugging Maggie. Perhaps she has not mentioned it to you. I have written her a number of times without response. I do not know what it is, but I think it best to let events wash it out. I do have some suspicions. The last thing I want to do is embarrass her, so if she is holding something against me, just do not arrange for us to meet, unless that would embarrass her more. Be aware of this and do what you think best. I can not imagine having consciously done anything to warrant this but I can imagine things she has been told that are not true.

If send when you finish the ms, do not send it when you send your suggestions without finding out if I'll need that copy with me. Perhaps I will. J may not have been able to recapture one in SF that I'm ~~xxx~~ depending on.
