Dear Steve,

Just returned from another exhausting but quite successful 10 days in New Orleans. Way behind and brought two weeks of solid work back. I think I have made a major breakthrough about which I can say nothing and encourage you to silence. We'll have to work, wait and see. So will Wesley.

Enclosed are a few more samples of Mark's modesty. I have sent copies to Louis Ivon, with the same caption on the Washington mailing and a similar one on the PW cover ad. If I can persuade my wife to do it, I'll also send around a copy ~~for~~ of the letters (unanswered) I sent Holt, Rinehart.

So, young friend, strong disbeliever, now you begin to see what I have been telling you, and now, perhaps, you understand why you got cut out of your assignment. All you need do is read the Press story to understand that Mark did all the work on the Zapruder film, whereas I labored under the misapprehension that I first published most of it, that Ray and Lillian made major discoveries, and he contributed nothing - not even when he was supposedly working in the Archives and had access to it before his book was published.

Why, he didn't even notice that the film was damaged - or doctored. Read his book, or consult the index.
