It would be inadvisable for me to ask Hargis for anything, particularly anything on Bringuier. He has repetitiously filed frivolous suits against me. This past Wednesday and the Wednesday two weeks earlier he received heavy blows in court. I intend suing him as soon as I can. I would like very much to have a copy of the pamphlet you refer to and the citation to Bringuier for his "Americanism". How these people abuse words!

If I can get to the west coast, I'll let you know in advance. Getting from San Francisco or L.A. to your part should not cost too much.

By the way, I believe Hargis published a pamphlet by Bringer on Cuba. The title escapes me, but I imagine it is still in print.



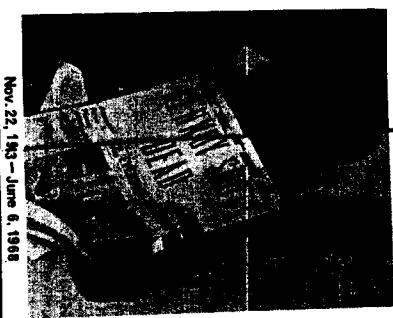

KLAMATH FALLS, ORE. (OCI)—Still unknown are the present whereabouts of G. Clinton Wheat, a former resident of the Klasmath Falls area, who, on May 13, was subpoenaed by D. A. Jim Garrison. The New Orleans official subpoenaed Wheat after hearing the testimony of Loren E. Hall, of Kennewick, Wash., a bartender who once was active in anti-communist activities both in this country and China as wheat is known by Garrison in December 1967, but did not go to New Orleans until last month.

After Wheat was subpoenaed for Garrison on May 13, attempts were made to find him by following the floor-to-ceiling cabin near the top of the New Orleans Hilton hotel near the New Orleans Convention Center. Hunt or his associates had been in New Orleans when they violated their job of office," and that Americans, like the German generals, had the right of resistance. Hunt stated "a prison term is not the least the leaders should consider should be given to anyone who is not a 'Comm' but a 'Communist' but later called that "only a figme of speech". He insisted he never would have advocated shooting the president. He stated "I am not a Communist, but I am a member of the Klasmath Falls Citizens Committee." 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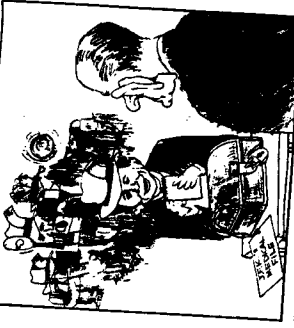


Photo of Ray Near JFK Slaying
