Spock Praised

2d Time Around

NEWARK, N.J., Oct. 31 (AP)—Ramsey Clark, U.S. attorney general when a federal grand jury indicted Dr. Benjamin Spock on conspiracy charges, has cited the pacifist-pediatrician again—this time with praise.

Clark presented an award given to Spock by the New Jersey chapter of the American Civil Liberties Union.

In making the presentation Saturday night, Clark said:

"I have come to indict Dr. Spock again, on three counts. One, putting the love of people against his own self-interest; secondly, persevering for peace, and, thirdly, conspiring to do this with youth, joy, grace and dignity rarely seen on this earth."

Spock was convicted of conspiring to counsel young men to evade the draft but the conviction was overturned.
