THE DALLAS POLICE TAPES ARE THE ACTUAL RECORD OF CONVERSATIONS BETWEEN THE DISPATCHER AND OFFICERS ON NOVEMBER 22, 1963- AT THE TIME OF THE KENNEDY MOTORCADE AND SUBSEQUENT ASSASSINATION. "WINCHESTER," ORIGINALLY DISCOVERED BY DALLAS POLICE. ANOTHER TRANSMISSION, AFTER THE TIPPIT MURDER, RESULTED IN THE CAPTURE OF OSWALD- ALTHOUGH THE DESCRIPTION OF THE SUSPECT DID NOT MATCH THAT OF OSWALD. WE HAVE AVAILABLE: CHANNELS ONE & TWO OF THE DALLAS POLICE TAPES ON STANDARD CASSETTE TAPE. INCLUDES BROADCAST AT TIME OF ASSASSINATION, THE DESCRIPTION OF THE SUSPECT, CONVERSATIONS WITH OFFICER TIPPIT- INCLUDING TRANSMISSIONS BY WITNESSES OF HIS MURDER, THE PURSUIT OF THE SUSPECT, TO THE ARREST OF OSWALD AT THE TEXAS THEATRE.

KENNEDY ASSASSINATION NEWSREEL FOOTAGE

THIS FILM COMPRISES VINTAGE "NEWS OF THE DAY" FOOTAGE FROM THE HEARST METROTONE NEWS FILES, RECORDED NOV. 22-24/1963 AT TIME OF JFK MOTORCADE. ENTITLED "TRAGEDY IN DALLAS"- THE RARE FOOTAGE INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING SEQUENCES:

- ** JFK arrival at Love Field on Nov. 22 morning, with LBJ and Gov. Connally.
- ** Presidential motorcade through the Dallas downtown area, w/ close-ups.
- ** Crowd reaction around Parkland Hospital as motorcade arrives following shooting. Includes footage of the Presidential limousine before removal.
- ** Lee Harvey Oswald at the Dallas Jail, following his apprehension. Including extreme close-ups (with excellent views of Oswald clothing— compare to Altgen's photo) as the accused assassin makes his "I'm a patsy" declaration to reporters, as he is being escorted through hallway by Dallas Police.
- ** Excellent close-ups of the Mannlicher-Carcano rifle, as the "murder-weapon" is examined by Police following discovery at Book Depository Bldg.
- ** OSWALD MURDER BY RUBY. Includes footage in basement of Dallas Jail, on Nov. 24, as Oswald is being transferred to the County Jail. Sequence features an unobstructed view of Oswald as he is escorted by police, is accosted by Ruby and is murdered- with freeze/frame close-ups of shooting. Also includes the subdual of Ruby and spectator reaction as he is arrested.

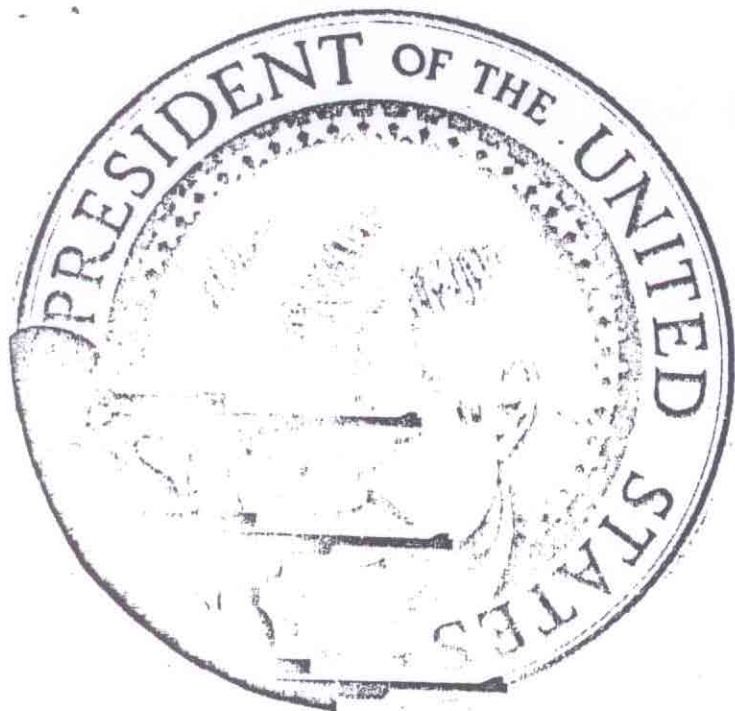

- ** ALGERIS PHOTO: The famous still photo of JFK motorcade (at Zapruder frame 255) revealing Book Depository Bldg. entrance, and "Oswald" figure six floors lower than it should be. Photo is 8 X 10, B & W, glossy (as original)....\$ 7.50
- Extreme blow-up, enlargement of Depository entrance area- defining "Oswald" figure, with excellent view of clothing worn (compare to Oswald's at time of his apprehension.) Photo is 8 X 10, B & W, glossy (blow-up).....\$ 7.50
BOTH PHOTOGRAPHS: (as above).....\$12.00
- ** HUGHES PHOTO: The frame from film by Robert Hughes reveals JFK motorcade as it rounds corner at Elm/Houston, beneath Book Depository. Entire facade is revealed (& 6th fl. windows) Photo is 8 X 10, Color (as original).....\$ 8.50

- ** MOORMAN PHOTO: The controversial still photo by Mary Ann Moorman, as the Presidential car passed her in Dealey Plaza. This is the photo taken closest the JFK auto, as it is under fire. (An amateur/polaroid photo- quality is grainy/clarity fair. Photo is 8 X 10, B & W, glossy (as Original)....\$ 7.50
- ** WILLIS PHOTO: The fifth photograph in the series of stills taken by Phil Willis- records the Kennedy limousine at the moment first shot strikes. Grassy knoll area is in background. Photo is 8 X 10, Color (as original).....\$ 8.50
- ** ZAPRUDER 313: The historic frame from the Abraham Zapruder film as the motorcade passes the grassy knoll and the President is struck by the fatal shot, exploding his skull. Photo is 8 X 10, Color (as original).....\$ 8.50
- ** RFK MURDER SITE PHOTO: This photo taken in pantry area of Ambassador Hotel- following murder of RFK, reveals Los Angeles police examining a 9th bullet hole in doorframe. This was never later acknowledged in official investigation as all shots from Sirhan's 8 bullet revolver had been accounted for. (This photo is also available with a literature package.)
