Dear Mr. Osborn,

Thanks for your letter of the 3rd and the enclosures, which I've read.

There is another suit not mentioned in this writing. Margaret Carroll, former roommate of Mary Jo Kopechne, is suing Ehrlichman, Caulfield and Ulasewicz. The Halperin suit is better known.

I had only limited evidence of interest me in the DC area. I know of a U.S. Attorney telling another attorney, in private practise, when I was in his office. That lawyer was not then in his office, so this was not learned by a tap. And I presume I was overheard incidental to my conversations with IPS people. My specific knowledge is outside the Washington area.

There was a time when I had an informant inside the "inutemen. From what I got from him I know of the success of some of their spying on the left. I presume from this that they also served as federal informants. They claim to have penetrated the Weatherpeople. If you ever come across anything along this line, it would be of interest to me in connection with a book and friend and I are doing jointly. One such informant, Larry Grantwohl, has already surfaced.

My friend has been or will be in touch with Schwartz, thanks.

If you know any of the former Army Intelligence people who operated in the Minneapolis area and went public, I'd like to be in touch with them over an incident back in 1968.
