Who is
Connally
Raps Book,
Plans Own

SAN ANTONIO, Tex. (UPI) — Gov. John Connally has announced plans to write a book on the Kennedy assassination "rather than leave the slanted, biased (William) Manchester book to go down as the only chronicle people can look back on."

CONNALLY, who was gravely wounded in the gunfire that killed President Kennedy in Dallas, Nov. 22, 1963, objected to Manchester's newly published "The Death of a President."

Connally several months ago criticized what he called "journalistic scavengers" he said were distorting the record of the assassination.

AT THE TIME he singled out Mark Lane, the New York lawyer and one-time attorney for Mrs. Marguerite Oswald. Lane wrote "Rush to Judgment."
