The dates are the best guesses I can now make. I kept no records of such things.

Place of birth: Philadelphia, Pa.

Dates at University of Delaware: 1930-3 (No degree- left after father's death.)

Newspapers: Wilmington Morning News, Wilmington Sunday Star (1930-); correspondent
Philadelphia Ledger syndicated Sunday section (1930-3). Others, occasional correspondent.

Magazines: regular during period of free-lancing, Washington correspondent of Click
(it was then 3rd largest picture magazine) 1940-2.

O.S.S. dates: 1943-7.

Perhaps I didn't say, perhaps you don't care, but 1936-9 I was a Senate editor and
investigator.

There were two Dell reprints, not "new editions". I've added the second.

I am not now free-lancing. I am working on books only.

Sorry I can't be more specific after all these years.
