If it is possible, I would like to review testimony
of following witnesses:

1. De Morienschildt
2. All witnesses testifying about Oswald during the
time he was first in Moscow, including the girl
newspaper reporter I have mentioned several times.
3. All witnesses connected with the U. S. Embassy in
Moscow, and with State Department, who have
testified regarding the issuance of U.S. passports
to Lee and Marina Oswald. (I do not need Marina
Oswald's testimony).
4. All witnesses connected with State Department
either at New Orleans or Washington who testified
concerning issuance of passport and visa to Oswald
at New Orleans.

Miss Ruth Midthun, my secretary, who will bring them to me and I will
sign for same.
