- 2:05 p.m. Bob MacNeil - Dallas
Assassin believed to have fired from a building overlooking parade route. People fanned out and asked if they saw anyone at a window. White man seen in window with rifle.
- 2:15 p.m. Charles Murphy - Dallas
Reports a young man has been taken into custody, protesting vehemently his innocence--young man in early 20's, neatly dressed.
- 2:19 p.m. Tom Whelan - Dallas
Interview with Jean Hill eyewitness to shooting. Describes what she saw--saw a man running. Heard two shots ring out.
- 2:36 p.m. Bob MacNeil - Dallas
.... Dallas police put in stringent protection forces as they had expected some demonstration such as that which greeted Adlai Stevenson short time ago. Shots came from building called Texas School Book Depository.
- 2:49 p.m. Charles Murphy - Dallas
Reports car has been stopped at Fort Worth with some possible connection with shooting. A Dallas police officer shot to death two miles from scene of assassination. (A suspect is now in custody.)
- 3:00 p.m. Bob MacNeil - Dallas
Dallas police made strong campaign to make sure Dallas' name would not be dragged in mud by extremists. Assassin was probably in fourth floor window 100 yards away from spot President's car passed.
.... TSBD is about 8 floors high. With high-powered rifle, would have been possible to hit the President at this distance.
- 3:13 p.m. Tom Whalen - Dallas
Weapon found in TSBD--British 303 rifle on 6th floor with telescopic lens, 3 empty cartridge cases found beside weapon--sniper's nest--appeared as if person had been there for some time.
