There has been a great deal of talk lately praising the accuracy of the Warren Report. This talk comes for the most part from commentators, editorialists, and magazine writers, almost none of whom has read the report (including the 26 volumes of depositions, exhibits, and affidavits) in its entirety.

It is hard to understand how these people (who are so uninformed generally about the Oswald case) can have made such an eager, greedy emotional commitment regarding the verdict of the government report. One wonders at the psychological need behind their failure to explore and dissect the presented facts. Certainly if the Accepters had read the report in detail they would not have voluntarily painted themselves into such a historically reprehensible corner. Examined in depth, the Warren Report is often wrong; is full of unchallenged contradictions in witness testimony; and is based on a closed-mind approach. In other words, it was written to comfort to comfort, rather than to reflect the truth AT ANY COST.

For these reasons, there is no doubt in our minds that the judgment as brought in by the Warren Commission will be overturned. To believe otherwise would be to disbelieve in God, reason and justice. We also believe that anyone who reads the 26 volumes of the Warren Report in their entirety will feel as we do, and we ask only that you accomplish this task before brushing aside our protest and before adding your name to the silly list of The Accepters.
