Jesse Core normally extended courtesies to the FBI made possible by his Trade-Mart position, especially in consection with the visits of foreign personneges, always a security problem. He feels that when he phoned the FBI at the time FBO picketed the ITM they came only as a courtesy to him. The agent, he is pretty cortain, was Comnor, who he knew well. e was told the FBI knew of Cawald, that he had been arrested a week earlier. It is also possible that the egent was another he knew well and likes.

ohn B. Alice (Ah-lee' say). He saved the wrinkled one he had earlier crumpled and thrown in Savald's face and later retrieved from the gutter) for himself. It is this one of which he gave me a copy.

He is positive he did not give the leaflet to deBrueys because he is confident deBrueys was not the first agent to see him (that was later). I gave him copies of the FRI reports. He also know debrueys well.

After the assassination, on 11/22/63, when reminded of this incident by Bill Martin, later on Gar ison's staff, Core phoned the FBI to remind them of the 8/18/63 incident. "The acted like they couldn't care less", he says.
