In connection with our investigation concerning the death of Martin Luther King, Jr., there is set forth below the estimated cost to the Bureau through the close of business May 31, 1968.

The total estimated cost is \$1,117,870. A peak of 3,075 field agents was assigned to this case and 5,380 hours of unpaid overtime have been performed. Bureau automobiles have been driven an estimated 448,775 miles.
