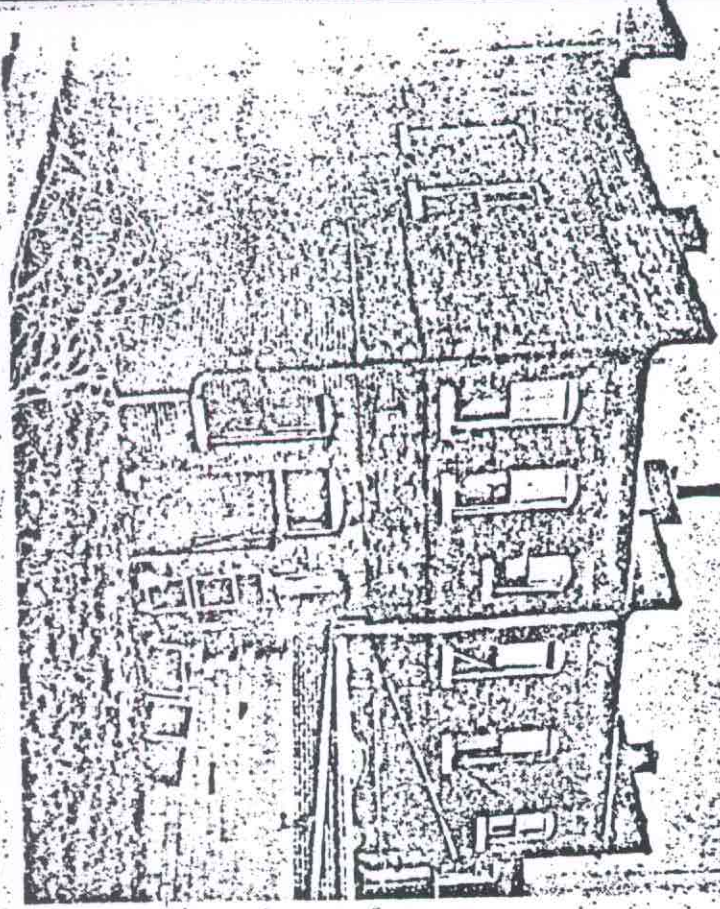


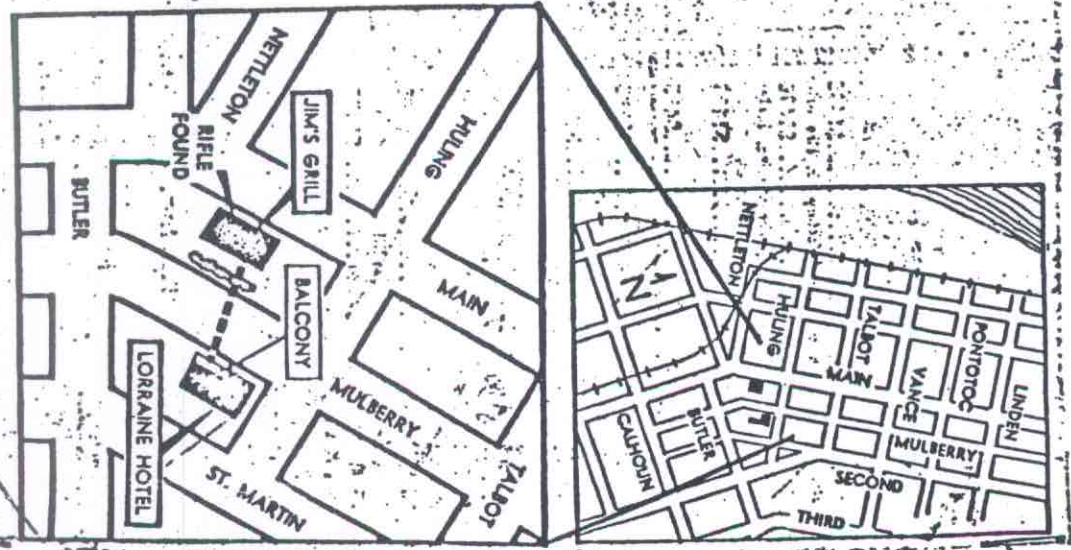

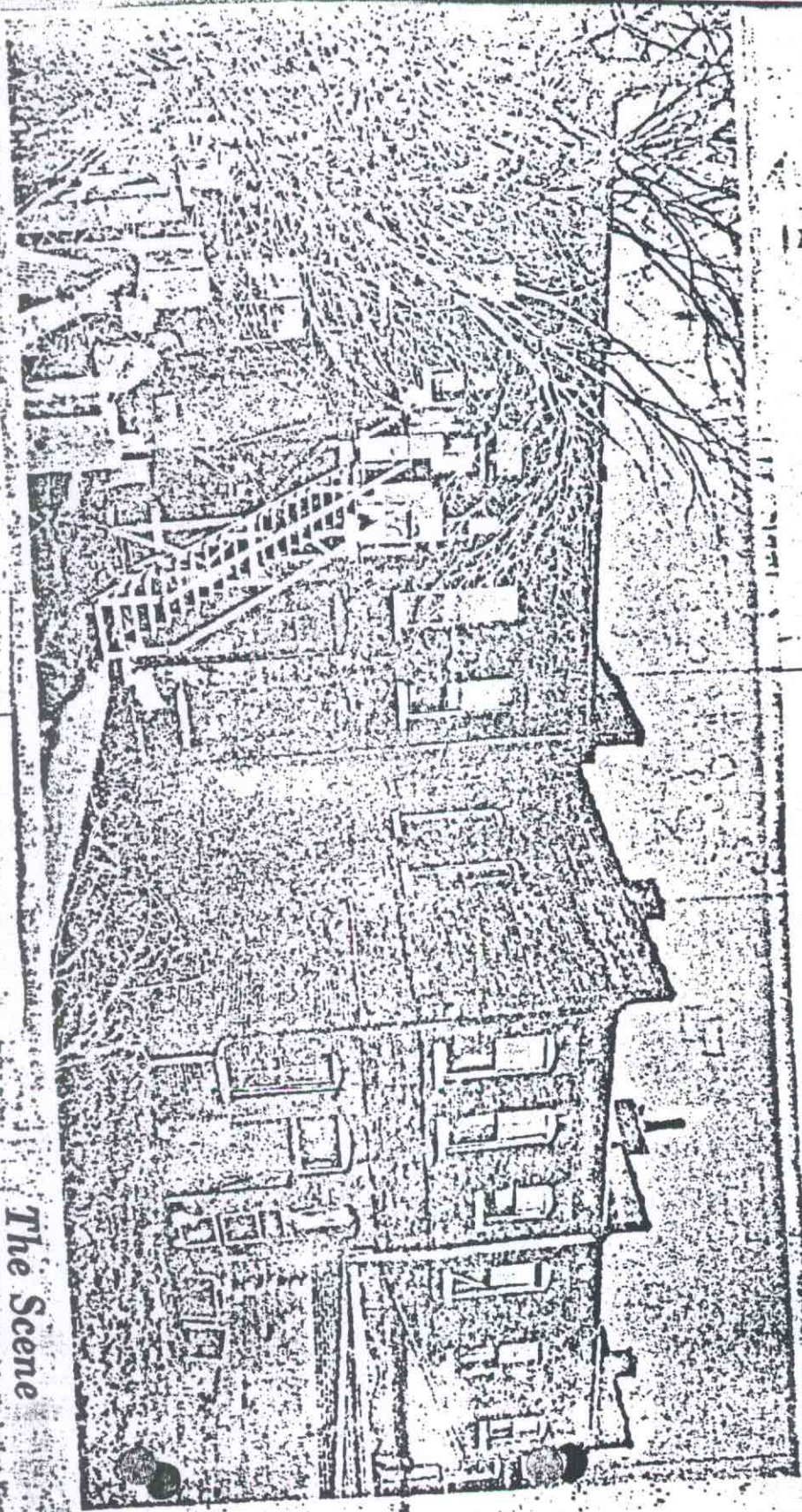
### The Scene
