Cuban Exile Wounded; Plotted to Invade Haiti

MIAMI, Nov. 23 (AP)—A Cuban exile convicted last February in connection with a plot to invade Haiti was shot and seriously wounded here Friday night, apparently machine-gunned from a passing car.

Met by a hail of bullets as he walked along a street in Miami's "Little Havana" section, Julio Aton Constanzo, 35, was wounded twice in the stomach and once in each leg.

Constanzo told police the shots came from a car. Eight shell casings of .45 caliber were found by police.

Constanzo, a former captain in Fidel Castro's early guerrilla forces in Cuba, was one of six persons convicted of help-

ing form a brigade that was to move against Haitian President Francois Duvalier. He was given 60 days in jail and a one-year suspended sentence.
