Exiles Shell Cuba, 2 Reported Killed

MIAMI—The Cuban government said yesterday that American-backed commandos had carried out a strafing attack on a fishing village on the north coast of the island Tuesday, killing two persons and injuring four others.

Radio Havana, in a broadcast monitored here, said the nighttime attack was carried out by two boats "from the north" and blamed it on "the government of the United States and its accomplices."

In New York a Cuban exile group headed by Jose Elias de la Torre claimed responsibility for the attack, called it a success and said that it was the beginning of a series of actions by the group to overthrow the government of Fidel Castro.

Radio Havana indicated that villagers and army patrols had fired back at the attackers but mentioned no casualties for the raiders, and there was no indication that they attempted to land.
