

'Pirate' Victims Return to Cuba

MIAMI, Fla., Oct. 16 (AP)—Eleven Cuban fishermen rescued near the Bahamas by a U.S. Navy helicopter after their two small boats were attacked by "bands of pirates" have returned to Cuba, Radio Havana reported today.

The broadcast, monitored in Miami, said a Cuban plane went to Nassau on Sunday to pick up the fishermen, who told Bahamian and American officials they were attacked by "pirates operating from U.S. territory" in international waters southwest of Andros Island last week. The radio broadcast denounced the action as a "cowardly and despicable aggression."
