Castro Foes Claim They Planted Bombs

Washington — (AP) — An anti-Castro organization calling itself the Cuban Secret Government says it placed bombs that damaged a travel agency and three offices which handle packages for Cuba.

The explosions occurred yesterday in Montreal, New York and Miami. There were no injuries, but the organization warned of further attacks against persons and firms who do business with Cuba.

"To do business with the Communist tyranny that oppresses Cuba means to recognize them as the legitimate government," a letter received at the AP Washington bureau said.
