One of them was an articulate and seemingly well-educated woman on the staff (and by this I do not mean to suggest medical staff) of the Bethesda hospital. She was present and from what she said I believed her.

She could not have been present on the floor or in any clerical position because the receipts signed by both FBI and SS were typed by a navy corpsman.

This would seem to indicate that there may have been other employees in ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> amphitheater.

This leads me to suggest that if you find any of <sup>them</sup> those who <sup>are</sup> were there willing to talk to you you may find it possible, through them, to learn of others.

The radio station was WABC, if you ask AARC if it has the tape. But I do not recall any identifier on it. She was careful about that and that impressed ~~me~~ me then.
