Dear Cardinal Cushing,

Because of your interest and your public statement of several months ago, I am taking the liberty of sending you a copy of PHOTOGRAPHIC WHITEWASH: SUPPRESSED KENNEDY ASSASSINATION PICTURES. It is the third part of my own "report on the Warren Report". Several more will follow.

While on a subject like this, I think it can never be said "my research is complete", I have completed most of the digging I expect to be able to do. I believe that when I send you what I have not yet published but will as soon as I can, you will understand how great an understatement you made.

Publishers still seem to fear this subject, that is, forceful, passionate and uncompromising writing on it that is not in accord with the official version. Thus, I have to publish my work myself. This is a great labor and slows us down, for there are out two of us.

Nonetheless, it will not be too long before I send you another instalment. I am hopeful that a small publisher will bring out the fourth part, completed as the third in early April. The publisher who had contracted for it declined it despite editorial approval. It is entitled CIA WHITEWASH: OSWALD IN NEW ORLEANS.

I hope you will not find the documents in the enclosed book to great a strain on your eyes. I reproduced them exactly as they are in what I consider to be a shameful archive to the murder of a President, an archive in which there are virtually no original documents and a majority that are less clear than they could and should be and in which a great many are illegible.

Save for what the Commission has already published, you will find in the 150 pages of photographic reproductions 100% of the material I cite.
