Thank you very much for answering my letter.


I can tell you in connection with the French television program you asked me about, that I indeed did tape it, only it is the Dutch version of it. This version is basically the same, it is only a bit longer. This two hour program was broadcast on two separate days, namely July 3 and 10, 1979 on the second Dutch channel and the commentary was in Dutch (the interviews were left in English).

They indeed did show a very clear Zapruder film in colour and they used it in the following way : the narrator talked about a possible second gunman and to prove this, the film was shown, first in the normal speed, then in slow motion with the accent on frame 313. Then there was an interview with Cyril Wecht who also believed in a second gunman, with an eye witness, and again with Wecht. Then the film was shown again. The whole part lasted in all 4 minutes. They used it a second time to demonstrate that Mary Moorman was visible in it when her pictures were discussed together with the wooden fence. Much more attention was paid in the program to the Nix film. The original version and the F.B.I. version were both shown and discussed.

In my opinion it was a very fine program and they also showed a similar one about Robert Kennedy.
