Dear Ms. Daix,

All my publication is on the subject of the JFK and King assassinations. My books come entirely from the official evidence and espouse no theories. These are rich fields for criminal justice studies and research if the theories that get most attention are ignored.

The list of my books is enclosed.

All I have is freely available for research. I used the Freedom of Information Act to obtain withheld official records in both cases. I obtained about a third of a million pages by a dozen or more FOIA lawsuits.

I thought I'd never hear from my alma mater when for more than 30 years I did not. I do not attribute this to having been fired by the then librarian, William Ditto Lewis, when I was a part-time student librarian paid ninety cents for a night's work back in the early 1930s. He had ordered me to catch and kill a kitten that had blundered into the library and for three days had taken no food. Repugnant as that was to me, the ninety cents was important to me so for my first drowning of a kitten I was fired - and by the man who had ordered it.

It was the Memorial Library then, the neutral ground between the men's and the separate women's colleges. It was also the maximum distance women were permitted at night without prior permission.

I'm 83 now and in impaired health. All my work will be a free public archive at local Hood College.

If you have a map reflecting the university's expansion I'd like to see it. It was not very large in the early 1930s.
