Dear Mary,

If you have had occasion to keep such records, I'd be interested in knowing who was arraigned for the rest of the night of 11/22/63 after Oswald was charged with the Tippit murder.

Some of the copies of my limited editions have been returned. I have sent Paul a copy of the first part of COUP suitable for recopying. It will take a little while before it reaches him. I think this gives him a copy of everything. If he makes the copies you and a few others want from the one I sent him, it will be clearer than if he makes it from a copy of these copies.

I have written two of the three parts of my study of the autopsy and I have the third part (tentatively called III), as I believe I told you. I am pretty sure Paul has both if you want one to keep. If you would like to borrow them and read them, I can lend them to you.

With the two parts of COUP, there are some additional corrections we have picked up since they were xeroxed and there are more of which I have a record. If you find any errors, typos or of fact, I would appreciate being told. The same is true of the two parts of OBT MORTEN. What changes the length of a paragraph is close to impossible because of time, but not others. (Lil just doesn't have time for that much work, I don't have time to repage, and the index is almost carded.) You may have some data on some of the Dallas people mentioned. I'd welcome it, especially on Jimmy Robinson. I have written an addition to the addition, the second part, but it is not long. I also a few notes amplifying and updating the first part, and I have almost completed an extensive appendix. It is an enormous book.

It seems like there is always so much I have to do I cannot finish with the daily work and with COUP, but when I do I will reread both parts of IM and write the third. I have perhaps my most exciting and significant material for it. I do have what the WC did not have. If they had, they could not have written this Report, it is that kind of thing.

My Dallas inquiries about the picture Curry uses on p.88 have had no response. Do you know if it is one they gave the SC? The Archives has not yet answered this inquiry, but sometimes they never answer me, sometimes they take months, sometimes they lie. I've been waiting for months for a list of the Ferris references, for example. Best,
