Dear Paul,

This memo, after our phone conversation today, is intended to remind me as much as inform you. I'll give it to you when you are here.

What I would like to get from the morgues of the Atlanta papers is everything they have on Dr. Aleksei Devison, of whom I spoke to you Saturday. Were it possible for me to spend the time at the Library of Congress and check the key dates as I know them, I might still miss a significant feature of story not keyed to the major events of interest to me.

If Galvan has a relationship with either or both librarians that would enable him to ask for xeroxes of what they have, it could be valuable. In turn, I promise you that when we have this all wrapped up and in context, it will be given to you. It is a small part of a larger story a small part of which I told you.

Father (Hal McCluney Devison, \* famous doctor, died 4/27/68) last address 2888 Hebersham Rd. Second son Peter, Captain, USAF. Aleksei not in Atlanta practise on last report. Mother White Russian refugee World War I. Both parents in Siberian expeditionary force, later Red Cross.

I realize from what you said this might be impossible, but if you'd ask Galvan when you can, on the chance he has a personal friend at either place, I would appreciate it.
