On 6/26/68 Lt. E. H. ARKIN, Intelligence
Bureau, Memphis, Tennessee, Police Department, furnished
to SA WILLIAM H. LAWRENCE a copy of a report dated 6/26/68
given to ARKIN by police undercover agent, code name
re his 6/25/68 activities with Black Organizing Project
(BOP) and Community on the Move for Equality (COME).
This report reads as follows:

Then left the car & source & Derrington went to the Star Dust Cate on Beale St. here — ran into Chas, Cabbage, Herman Pruitt & Don Neely. They were talking about the COME meeting to be held at 1st Baptist Church later on Jane 26, 1968. The proprietor of the cate came over and told this group they couldn't say if they didn't buy something. Then moved outside in front of the Old Daisy Theatre. While standing out ide Hurley Gibson came up. Informant & Gibson then cent to Henry's Pool Room & shot a fer games of pool. After that left pool room ran into House & Harrington in front of the Parlem Bouse and all sent down to the 1st Baptist Church on Beale St. as it was almost 7:30 pm.

Twhen we got to the church, pastored by Rev. James A. Jordan. 1840 Boyle - 946-6371, 379 Heale (church) 527-4832, no one there but the minister or pastor of the church & Heall Famon & Charles Cabbase the were sitting around talking to the pastor.

"We here at the church about 5 min, when Emmitt House soggested that we go to the mit, at 1644 Hanauer #2 and pick up the Robutussin At and bring it back down to therebert I' who was at the Harlem Pouse.

"The COMA meeting at 1st Bactist Church started at 8:30 pm. Those typesent: nev. Lavson L.v. P. halph Jackson, Cornelius Crenshan, Mrs. Tarlesc Mathers, Biston Trotter, FNU Trotter, 77 yls, M/C 5'10" 160%, broan skinged low cut hair conservative, hangs out with Nev. Latson, Smith, Chas. (Abhage, Harrington, House, Famon, Arthur Norwood, Johnnie (LNU), M/C 5'11" 160% dark comp. small gotee, short med, hair 22 yrs, Nev. L. R. Donion sho acted as Chairman of the meeting and arroy 15 others (adults mired males & remales).

"Fieting began with Rev. Larson processing that the reading & adoption of the consitution be post; oned till next Tues. July 2, 1968. John Smith & Chas. Cabbage anted to go ahead with the meeting and the business at band and forget about all of this formal protocol this groupted an argument between Invaders & Rev. Larson & Jackson.

The con gave in and read the constitution but he couldn't let them vote on it.

"Another argument insued at which time hev. Jackson moved that the meeting adjourn at which time trey started to get up and leave but Evall lamon & Arthur Nor ood closed the door on the command of Chis. Cabbage & didn't let anyone out.

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"Nev. Jackson threatened Reald Famon that he would get a corrant for his arrest it he didn't let them leave. Chas, Cabbage told Famon to let them go & Jackson & Lavson & Auprox. 15 other left the meeting.

"After they had gone Chas, (abbage nominated the pastor of the 1st Baptist Ch. to the nee Chairman of COMS (Pev. James A. Jordan), and he was voted in.

'Earrington nominated Corpelia Cresshas as Secretary & who was voted in.

"1st order - John B. Smith and to those where all of COME's money was?

"and order of day was to establish a fact finding Committee to look into the sinances of COME.

"ird order was to accept the constitution read earlier.

"4th order - setting of a new meeting for 7/2/68, 7:30 p, af 1st Bapt, Ch., at which time they will elect permanent officers.

"Henson Invaders want this take byer was for the money in COME. COME 23,000,00/in bank, \$1300 a month for 14 mo, from Labor Union VISTA- vol. in service to America. promised 40,000.00 if COME is acce ted a incorporated.

Lt. ARKIN also jurnished a copy of the "Proposed Plan of Organization for Community on the Move for Equality" (tentative) which was read at the above meeting, a copy of which is attached hereto to each comy of this memorandum,
