On 12/20/63, Mr. J. R. FREEMAN, Dallas Morning News, advised that an agent of the Dallas Office has during the past few days interviewed several female employees of the Society Section of the Dallas Morning News. He said the Agent made inquiry regarding an incident that involved an ambulance picking up a young person off the street about five minutes before the Presidential motorcade arrived at the Houston-Elm Street intersection on 11/22/63. He stated he has learned that BUSTER HAAS, who works in the news room during the evening and night hours (and who could be contacted at home during the day, telephone CA 4-1280) can furnish considerable information regarding the above referred to incident as HAAS had a position of vantage and viewed this entire incident as well as the motorcade.

FREEMAN said MARY ELIZABETH WOODWARD, who works days in the Society Department (home phone TA 4-4376), was one of the girls interviewed a couple of days ago, but she has recalled additional information that she is desirous of furnishing to the Dallas Office and asked to be recontacted.

LEADS

1. Will interview BUSTER HAAS, telephone CA 4-1280, for all information that he may be able to furnish pertinent to captioned matter.

2. Will reinterview MARY ELIZABETH WOODWARD, telephone TA 4-4376, or at her employment at Dallas Morning News to develop additional information that she has regarding captioned matter. It is noted that the original interview with WOODWARD appears in 100-10,461-62547.
