MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR, FBI

Subject: Resumption of National Archives and Record Service  
Approved Schedule for Destruction of FBI Files

In response to your request of May 13, 1977, I approve the FBI's destruction of files pursuant to the National Archives and Records Service Plan, subject to the following conditions: **preservation of all records relating to cases in litigation and preservation of those records which the Select Committee on Assassinations has asked to be retained.** I am aware that the existing records destruction plan is now undergoing review and that it is anticipated that a new plan will be approved. I do not want any new plan implemented until such time as I have had an opportunity to review it, but you may continue to destroy records under the existing plan.

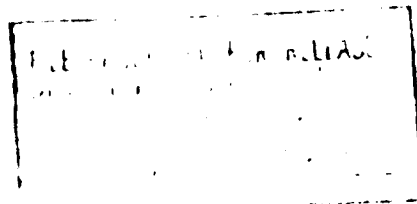
I have advised the relevant congressional committee chairmen of our intention to resume destruction and no objection has been raised by them.
