For information of the Bureau, Special Agent in Charge JOHN RICE, Secret Service, New Orleans, telephonically advised 9/11/64 that he had received a telephone call from Secret Service Headquarters in Washington, D. C. Mr. RICE advised that the Warren Commission had inquired of headquarters of Secret Service in Washington if the Secret Service Office in New Orleans had copies of a circular called "Fair Play For Cuba" with address stamped on bottom "544 Camp Street, New Orleans, Louisiana".

Mr. RICE advised they did not have any copies of such a circular and he was merely calling the New Orleans FBI Office to advise of the Warren Commission's interest in obtaining a copy of this circular.
