SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

On November 22, 1963, I was assigned to the Dallas Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and was engaged in conducting investigations at Dallas, Texas. I did not witness the Presidential motorcade in Dallas, Texas, on November 22, 1963.

It is now my recollection that at some time before noon on November 22, 1963, I was conducting an investigation on Second Avenue, south of the Fair Park area in Dallas, Texas. Upon completion of the investigation at that location, I proceeded to an area just off Illinois Avenue, approximately four miles from the downtown area. Upon completion of an interview there, I returned to the car that I was driving, and was proceeding in a westerly direction on Illinois Avenue when a broadcast was made over the FBI radio that some shots had been fired as the Presidential motorcade was passing the Texas School Book Depository Building at Elm and Houston Streets. I immediately proceeded to the Texas School Book Depository Building.
