It should be noted that the above listed items in the subject's address book with the legible addresses written in the English language have been set forth above. There were as many items written in the Russian language which could not be readily copied.

In the subject's effects there were also the following items:

A pamphlet from the New York School for Marxist Studies, Fall term, 10/11-25/63.

A study of USSR and Communism by ALFRED J. RIEBER and ROBERT C. NELSON, published by Scott Forman & Co.

The subject's effects also had an application for a Texas Driver's license. In addition to the known descriptive data he listed his occupation as photographer and under the box for race he had a capital "C", which normally stands for colored.
